HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL,
on the recommendation of the Minister of the
Environment, pursuant to paragraph 3(b) of the Lake of
the Woods Control Board Act, is pleased hereby to
approve the regulation and control of the waters of Lac
Seul so as to maintain the level of the lake between the
elevations of 352.4 metres (1,156.168 feet) and 357.2
metres (1,171.916 feet) above mean sea level, with the
upper 0.3 metres (0.984 feet) considered a flood reserve
and the lower 1.2 metres (3.937 feet) considered a
drought reserve, as recommended by the Lake of the Woods
Control Board at its meeting of April 6, 1989. The
datum for these elevations is the preliminary adjustment
of 1923 referred to as Bench Mark 988-A, elevation
1,183.075 feet, which equates to elevation 1,183.740
feet Geodetic Survey of Canada, 1929 adjustment.
